

## Village of Teslin

### By-Law #13-203

---

A Bylaw to regulate the conduct of the Municipal By-Election.

WHEREAS Division 15 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 154 of the Statutes of the Yukon (2002) and amendments thereto, provides that a Council may by bylaw regulate the conduct of a by-election.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act of the Yukon Territory, the Council of the Village of Teslin, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

#### SHORT TITLE:

1. This By-Law may be cited as the “Municipal By-Election Bylaw”.

#### INTERPRETATION

2. In this bylaw,
  - (1) “clerk” means the designated municipal officer of the Village of Teslin
  - (2) “council” means the Council of the Village of Teslin
  - (3) “elector” means a person qualified to vote in a municipal election pursuant to the Municipal Act
  - (4) “village” means the Village of Teslin.

#### ELECTION OFFICIALS

3.
  - (1) Theresa Brown is hereby appointed Returning Officer.
  - (2) The Returning Officer appointed by Council hereby has delegated authority to appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks as necessary.
  - (3) Election officials shall, during their employment, refrain from any active or public support or criticism of any candidate.

#### NOMINATIONS

4.
  - (1) Council Chambers located in the Village Office are hereby designated as the place for nomination proceedings.
  - (2) Nomination Day is January 23, 2014
  - (3) Nominations will be received by the Returning Officer no later than 12 o'clock noon on January 23, 2014.

#### PLACES AND HOURS OF POLLS

5.
  - (1) The advance polling place and the regular polling place shall be established at the Village of Teslin Council Chambers.

- (2) The advance poll shall be held February 6, 2014 and the hours of the poll shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- (3) The regular poll shall be held February 13, 2014 and the hours of the poll shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

#### FEES

6. The following rates shall be paid to the persons acting as election officials, other than full time officers and employees of the Village of Teslin.

Returning Officer	\$20.00 per hour
Deputy Returning Officer	\$18.00 per hour
Poll Clerk	\$16.00 per hour

7. (1) All persons entitled to vote in the municipal election shall be eligible voters as defined in Section 48 of the Municipal Act.  
  
(2) Prior to obtaining a ballot, all eligible voters will be required to register on the approved registration form, attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this bylaw, by swearing or affirming their eligibility to vote, and by recording their name, address and signature thereto.

#### REPEAL

8. Bylaw 11-189 is hereby repealed.

#### ENACTMENT

9. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on final passing thereof.

Read a first and second time this 16th day of December 2013.

Read a third time and finally passed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of January 2014.
