



## Village of Teslin

### By-Law # 09-168

---

#### **A By-law to close a municipal highway and to consolidate, amalgamate and subdivide lots owned by the Village of Teslin.**

**WHEREAS** the Council wishes to permanently close a municipal highway contained within the areas of Survey Plan 22684 for consolidation into Block 17 Lots 1 – 5 to include said municipal highway with the extension of the said lots in Block 17.

**WHEREAS** section 276 the Municipal Act being Chapter 154 of the Revised Statutes of the Yukon Territory (R.S.Y.2002) provides that Council may by bylaw close a municipal highway within their boundaries; and

**WHEREAS** section 313 and 315(1) (b) of the Municipal Act being Chapter 154 of the Revised Statutes of the Yukon Territory (R.S.Y.2002) provides that Council may apply to subdivide and may subdivide for the purpose of correcting or rearranging lots; and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable that the Village of Teslin ensure that Village of Teslin Recreational Facilities and Infrastructure is on land that is owned by the Village of Teslin and that the Teslin Historical and Museum Society have their infrastructure on land registered in their name;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Municipality of the Village of Teslin, in open meeting assembled hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

#### **Short Title**

1. This by-law may be known as the “Block 17 Municipal Highway Closure By-Law 2009”

#### **General Provisions**

2. The municipal highway to be closed is shown on the map attached as “Appendix A” and is situated between Block 16 lots 1 to 7 and Block 17 lots 1 to 5 and between Block 17 lot 5 and Block 18, with access points to this highway from Nisutlin Drive.
3. Block 17 lots 1 to 5 will be enlarged to include the annotated area immediately adjacent to it from the highway closure.
4. Block 18 will be reduced in size to encompass only the buildings commonly referred to as the George Johnson Museum and owned by the Teslin Historical and Museum Society.
5. Block 17 lot 5 will be enlarged to include the area presently occupied by the Tom Dewhurst Memorial Recreation Complex and lot 18 will be decreased accordingly.
6. Block 18 and Block 19 lots 1 and 2 will be transferred to the Teslin Historical and Museum Society for the sum of \$1.00.
7. A public hearing will be advertised then held on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2009 to allow for public intervention, discussion and review of written submissions, immediately preceding the regular meeting of council.

**Enactment**

8. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

Read a first time this 22nd day of December, 2008.

Read a second time this 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2009.

Read a third time and finally passed this 27th day of April 2009.
