

## **Village of Teslin**

### **By-Law # 06-146**

---

A Bylaw to provide for the support of a Recreation Society in and for the Village of Teslin.

WHEREAS Section 14 (1) and (2) of the Recreation Act, being Chapter of the Statutes of the Yukon (2002) and amendments thereto, and Section 265 (f) being Chapter 154 of the Statutes of the Yukon (2002) and amendments thereto, provides that a Council is responsible for all matters respecting the recreation of its residents and taking place in the community and outside the community between residents of other communities and can pass bylaws to this effect.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act of the Yukon Territory, the Council of the Village of Teslin, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

#### SHORT TITLE:

1. This By-Law may be cited as the “Recreation Provision Bylaw”.

#### INTERPRETATION

2. In this bylaw,
  - (1) “Society” means the Recreation Society as established locally and within the definition of the Societies Act of the Yukon Territory
  - (2) “Councillor” means any member of the Council of the Village of Teslin
  - (3) “Chief Administrative Officer” (CAO) means the employee appointed by Council to administer the daily business of the Municipality as per the policies of Council
  - (4) “Council” means the Council of the Village of Teslin
  - (5) “Village” means the Village of Teslin.

#### POLICY

3. Council shall appoint a representative at the start of each new term of office to be its representative on the Recreation Society and attend the Societies monthly meetings.
4. Council shall consult on matters affecting the development of Park and Recreational programs and the acquisition or disposal of park and recreational land, facilities and equipment.
5. Council will hear and consider representation by any individual organization or delegation of citizens with respect to recreation.
6. The Society may make recommendations to the Council regarding the passing of Bylaws, Rules or Regulations with respect to matters connected with the management, use, and operation of recreation facilities, lands, equipment and programs under the control of Council.

7. The Society shall recommend such action as it considers necessary to ensure that the maximum use and benefit is derived from all recreational facilities in the Village.
8. The Recreation Society shall appoint someone from the Society to sit on the interview panel when hiring a recreation programmer and/or recreation staff.
9. The Society shall recommend such policies and procedures as may be required from time to time with respect to the allocation of the annual lottery grant funds to organizations and individuals. The recreation society shall provide input on various requests made by organizations and shall provide information in a timely manner so as not to impede the decision of Council.
10. Annually, in November each year the Recreation Society will put forth it's budget estimating expenditures and revenues with regard to recreational programs.
11. The Recreation Society shall meet with the CAO of the Village on a monthly basis to plan, organize and provide input into the recreation programming.

REPEAL

12. Bylaw #8 is hereby repealed.

ENACTMENT

13. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on final passing thereof.

**Read a third time and finally passed this 28<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2006.**
